Welfare Unveil New Boss

Glasshoughton Welfare have moved swiftly to appoint a new Manager to replace Tim Hope who resigned at the start of the month.

The new man is Dave Holmes who has had previous management at Garforth Town prior to Simon Clifford taking over the club.

He has been a coach at Glasshoughton from the start of this season.

Dave's first priority is to take Glasshoughton away from the bottom of the table following their disastrous start to the season.

Speaking shortly after Hope's departure, a statement from Glasshoughton Welfare said: "The Club is sorry to lose Tim who was selected in the summer from an impressive list of applicants.

"Tim has decided to take this decision after a poor run of results which has seen only one win and one draw from seven matches including elimination from the FA Cup in a replay at Liversedge.

"The Club wishes Tim every success in the future and thanks him most sincerely for his dedication and hard work."

Hope added: "I am a proud man and have been unable to motivate the team to perform to an acceptable level.

"I am resigning now to enable my successor to have the time to turn things around."
