## TADCASTER ALBION BEAR BRUNT OF FLOODING

It has been an all-too-often sight over the years, but it does not get any easier for Tadcaster Albion as they have seen their Ings Lane ground once again become victim to flooding.

With it being in a vulnerable place right next to the River Wharfe, there is always a danger that the pitch could be underwater at any time.

And, this picture, courtesy of the *Tadcaster Albion Supporters Website*, shows the sight that greeted club officials when the river burst its banks on Saturday 6th September following the recent deluge of rain that hit the North of England.

At one stage, the pitch and car park were under at least a metre of water.

The water subsided throughout last week but did not disappear quickly enough to allow Saturday's home game with AFC Emley to go ahead.

It is the second time that Ings Lane has been flooded in 2008.

The last time was in January when extensive damage was caused to the playing surface and the clubhouse, just as the KoolSport NCEL Division One were trying to recover from an arson attack.

It led to a massive fundraising effort to keep Taddy going which included a prestigious pre-season friendly with York City in the Summer.

This time around, however, the clubhouse seems to have avoided any costly damage but it is not yet known when the Ings Lane surface will be suitable for football.

There is a fortnight before the next scheduled home game against Barton Town Old Boys in the League on the 27th of September and we'll all be hoping the weather stays fine between now and then.
