## NCEL In FA Vase Pledge

The KoolSport NCEL has announced a measure they hope will give its clubs a great chance to progress in the FA Vase next month.

The statement reads: "In an effort to assist its member clubs, the KoolSport NCE League have decided that the six clubs who have progressed to the next round of the FA Vase to be played on Saturday 6th December 2008 will not play any competitive NCE game in the midweek prior to this date.

"In doing so, the Management Board hope that this allows clubs a better preparation period for the important game in the next round of the FA Vase.

"This means that the Scarborough Athletic v Pickering Town in the Presidents Cup in that midweek will now be postponed and rearranged in early January."



## Dinno in "Come And Watch Us" Plea

KoolSport NCEL Premier Division side Dinnington Town have warned they need bigger attendances in order to survive.

They currently sit fourth in the average attendance table with 107 but the club want more to come and watch.

A statement on the club's website says: "Dinnington Town have seen a steady increase in the attendances since our Central Midlands days, when we were getting ten to fifteen turning out for a game.

"Most of these people were parents of the players, we even counted stray dogs in those days. The players paid £3.00 subs otherwise we couldn't afford to pay the referee. The players don't pay subs now but they have a go on the club lottery to generate some money that is necessary at this level.

"It has been difficult for the Club to encourage locals to come along when we have teams like Sheffield United, Wednesday, Rotherham and Barnsley on the door step.

"Is it better football? I think not. At Dinnington you can see more enthusiasm from the players who really do love the Club.

"Give me an NCEL game any day and at £4.00 adults and £2.00 children and OAP's - 'it's cheap as chips'.

"Down at Phoenix Park, three adults, six under 16's can have an excellent afternoon out for under £30.00 - they can also have a cup of OXO thrown in for that price.

"The recession has hit us all in some way but, with our supporters in mind, we have not increased our prices for two years.

"This year, we have seen increased League and Referee fees that eat into our match day profit.

"If it wasn't for the £70.00 we generate from the raffle and weekly lottery we would struggle to survive.

"The press have done us proud over the years to get the message across.

"So come on Dinnington supporters get down to Phoenix Park, get behind your team, encourage the players, pass the word to your friends and family that we are here, a lot of people don't know what they are missing."

## Kearney At Staveley

Staveley Miners Welfare's new boss has unveiled his first full signing, goalkeeper Martin Kearney from Hallam FC.

A string of highly regarded performances by Martin, pieced together with the ambitions of the new manager, Darren Bland, and the club, made the approach after the expiry of the 7-day period a formality.

The signing is part of the club's efforts to secure competition in all places and strengthen the squad with experience.

The Sandygate outfit were quick to say this recent signing of Martin and the signature of experienced keeper Jack Harvey from Long Eaton United for the reserves by Mick Eborall and Dave Mace is not an indication of a change of ethos or any blight on the existing goalkeepers at the club.

A spokesperson said: "Darren considers competition for places should be strong throughout the club and Mick was quick to point out that the reserves had been playing with 16- and 17-year-old keepers from the U19's.

"The more physical demands of the North Midlands Reserves League was something that had been more evident in certain games.

"And, with a young back four of an average age of just 19, a more experienced keeper was required to complement the squad."

This was part of the on-going ground development programme to satisfy FA Ground Grading Requirements as the club look to progress into the UniBond League.

Chairman Tony Dunning said: "A huge amount of planning was required for this project. The first objective was to obtain permission from all relevant departments/authorities.

"I would particularly like to thank the Cricket Club for their co-operation on this matter.

"The fence is quite a piece of engineering with 50 panels consisting of wooden slats held together by a steel frame, 51 holes in the ground, 0.5m square, 1.0m deep with steel sockets embedded in a concrete footing up to ground level (these are capped off during cricket season).

"51 steel posts sit in to the steel sockets and the panels are then bolted on.

"The project was managed by the club's Business Adviser Bill McCall.

"The fence was expertly designed and engineered by LH Sleightholme Ltd headed by Steve Marshall.

"My hat comes off to Steve who went way over and above the call of duty to deliver and without him we could not have possibly completed the project.

"The ground work/preparation was completed by J Thackray & Sons Steel Structures Ltd.

"Many thanks to Laurie and co. for all their patience regarding the unexpected boulders unearthed during the construction.

"The erecting and dismantling at each end of the football season takes 10 strong club members (or for that matter anyone we can drag off the street on a Sunday morning) approximately 3 hours using a mini tractor and trailer to transport the fence to its place of storage during the cricket season.

"A superb effort from everyone concerned, complements have been coming in from many different quarters!!!

"The funding to cover the cost of the fence came from many different areas such as donations, sponsorship etc.

"We were also awarded a substantial grant from the Football Stadia Improvement Fund (FSIF) through the Football Foundation."
