BOTTESFORD GET LIGHT FUNDING BOOST



Bottesford Town have been awarded £10,240 by the Football Stadia Improvement Fund (FSIF), supporters of the Football Foundation, and the largest funder of non-league football in the country.

"A vibrant community team is vital for the future of football.

"The Football Stadia Improvement Fund's aim is to revolutionise

funding for the grass roots in the same way the professional game has been transformed over the last ten years.

"I pay a particular tribute to the hard work and dedication all at the club for making this funding a reality."

Tony Reeve, Chairman of Bottesford Town FC, said: "On behalf of Bottesford Town FC, I extend our thanks to both the Football Foundation and the North Lincolnshire Council for their continual support of the Club.

"And, also the FA National Sports Centre Trust for their generous contribution to the project.

"We now look forward to the next phase of the ongoing developments at the Club which will hopefully see the fruition of two years of planning and preparation by members of the Club Management team for a Multi-Purpose Changing Room Development which will be for the use of all who play their sport at Birch Park, the home of Bottesford Town Football Club."

The funding represents 50% towards the replacement of outdated floodlights and associated switch and control gear.

The previous floodlights, incorporating second hand equipment, were installed in 1995 and, due to their condition, despite regular maintenance, struggled to meet the required level of illumination (average 120 lux) without the replacement of a significant number of light fittings.

The new floodlight installation meets the ground grading criteria for playing football at Step 2 of the Football Pyramid (average 180 lux).

Over £90m has already been invested by the Football Stadia Improvement Fund since its launch in July 2000, funding lower league ground improvements throughout professional and amateur game, creating a safe and modern environment for fans and players to enjoy the game.

Paul Thorogood, Chief Executive of the Football Stadia Improvement Fund and Football Foundation, said: "On behalf of the Football Stadia Improvement Fund, I am delighted to be able to award this grant to Bottesford Town FC.



A game is to be arranged in the New Year with a professional Football Club to mark the official switching-on of the lights.

Winterton Rangers player Lee Mohammed was taken to hospital by ambulance after breaking his leg in the 1-1 draw at Hallam.

He was stretchered off on the half-hour by ambulance staff and the game delayed for around thirty minutes.

It is believed he has suffered a break below the knee and dislocated his ankle while turning away from an innocuous challenge.

Winterton representative Wayne Turtle commented: "Lee is an enthusiastic member of the team and enjoyed success as part of the double winning squad.

"He has been working very hard to cement his place in the starting eleven and had recently rediscovered his shooting boots.

"It's a major blow to Lee personally and to Winterton who have now suffered two serious breaks this term.

"All at West Street wish him a speedy recovery."

Meanwhile, on the same day, Nostell Miners Welfare midfielder Paul Bedford also suffered a broken leg during his side's 2-1 victory at Eccleshill United.

McCain Setback For New Seadogs

Scarborough's hopes of a return to the McCain Stadium have suffered a setback.

The town's derelict former ground was given a repairs' estimate on Thursday by council engineers and Athletic will discover their findings in the New Year.

But, chairman Simon Cope has warned supporters of the KoolSport NCEL club that an emotional homecoming does not look promising.

He said: "At this moment, it is looking very doubtful. I'm told the stadium is not a pretty picture. It is in a right old state and, at this stage, we aren't confident at all.

"The damage done by vandals and the fires is a lot worse than we ever thought. The blaze under the main stand has wrecked the place - and the electrics will cost a bomb.

"Everything that can be smashed has been. We thought the damage was more superficial. There are also big problems with the terracing. The crash barriers need welding on again which is a big and costly problem."
