Arnold Town booked their place in the Final of the KoolSport NCEL Presidents Cup after two late goals saw them progress at the expense of Selby Town.

Joe Naylor and Tony Law struck in the last five minutes to send them through 2-0 at Eagle Valley and they will now meet either Winterton Rangers or Dinnington Town whose semi-final takes place in March.

In the Premier Division, another round of matches led to a change of table topper once again as Bridlington Town returned back to the summit.

Craig Burdick struck twice, once in each half, to give the Seasiders a 2-0 win "away from home" against their tenants, Scarborough Athletic, in front of a crowd of just over 700.

Brid are now a point clear of Rainworth Miners Welfare who dropped points in a 1-1 draw at home to next-to-bottom Lincoln Moorlands Railway.

Danny Bainbridge put the Wrens ahead on 30 minutes and it looked as though their winning run would stretch to seventeen games but Moorlands made sure of a point through Lee Beesley just after the hour mark.

With two games in hand over Bridlington, however, Rainworth remain slight favourites for the title.

And, Adam Walker's 25th minute strike earned Hall Road Rangers a 1-0 win at home to Liversedge.

Leeds Carnegie's lead at the top of Division One has been cut to just one point after they were beaten 3-1 at Brighouse Town.

Craig Smith put Brighouse in front on 24 minutes but John Hardy made sure the scores were level by the break.

But, Ben Charlesworth and Matthew Howgate struck late on to make it five wins out of five for Brighouse and move them to within six points of Carnegie in fourth spot.

Second-placed AFC Emley took full advantage with a 3-0 home victory over Worsbrough Bridge Athletic.

Steven Kenworthy grabbed a double whilst Lee Hill scored the third.

Another hat-trick hero was Jake Vernon who helped Rossington Main to a 4-3 victory at home to Askern Villa whilst Hemsworth Miners Welfare were 2-0 winners over visitors Teversal.

And, Yorkshire Amateur bowed out of the West Riding County Cup Quarter-Finals with a 3-0 defeat at Vodkat League side, Barnoldswick Town.

Bridlington Town's lead at the top of the KoolSport NCEL Premier Division has extended to three points after their 6-0 win at bottom side Brodsworth Welfare.

Craig Hogg chalked up a hat-trick, starting with Brid's only first half goal which came in injury time, whilst Tom Chippendale, Nathan Hotte and Chris Adams also found the net as the visitors took complete control after the interval.

Second-placed Rainworth Miners Welfare lost a little ground on the Seasiders as they were held to a last-grap 2-2 draw by Pickering Town at Kirklington Road.

Dave Thompson had the Pikes ahead on 26 minutes before Danny Bainbridge and Simon Asquith in the second period had seemingly given the hosts the win.

Long Eaton United and Liversedge move up into the top ten after home victories.

Adam Newton struck twice in Long Eaton's 3-2 win over Hallam, Kevin Mabon with the winner on 89 minutes after Phil Reynolds and Lee Naughton had netted for the away side.

And, Jamie Wasley's second half hat-trick earned Sedge a 4-2 scoreline against Arnold Town.

Brodsworth are now fourteen points adrift at the foot of the table after their closest rivals, Lincoln Moorlands Railway, drew 2-2 at home to Parkgate.

Joshua Schofield had Moorlands ahead on thirteen minutes but Nathan Swindells struck twice for their opponents before half-time.

However, a Simon Megson own goal with a quarter-of-an-hour remaining saw the hosts pick up only their eighth point of the season on their own patch.

Moorlands are three points behind Shirebrook Town who are just outside the bottom two following their 5-1 defeat at home by Dinnington Town, Danny Lindley grabbing two for the away side to move them up to eleventh.

And, Jimmy Jagger's injury-time equaliser snatched Nostell Miners Welfare a point in a 3-3 draw with visitors Selby Town.

With the top two clashing at Throstle Nest on Monday night, Saturday was a great day for the Division One chasing pack to close the gap a little.

Brighouse Town moved up to third and within two points of second with a 1-0 home victory over Grimsby Borough, Lee Burgess with the vital strike six minutes from time.

Tadcaster Albion are a further point behind, up into fourth, after Chris Storey's 85th minute winner claimed a 2-1 victory at home to Askern Villa after Daniel Taylor had cancelled out the home side's early opener from Marc Thompson.

Brighouse and Tadcaster move ahead of Staveley Miners Welfare who were beaten 3-0 at Hemsworth Miners Welfare, Wayne Harratt grabbing two from the penalty spot before Jon Impey claimed the third on 77 minutes.

Eccleshill United are off the bottom of the table for the first time in a long time after their 1-0 home win over Appleby Frodingham, Ryan Wood scoring on 44 minutes.

They are replaced in the basement by Worsbrough Bridge Athletic who lost 3-2 at Teversal who climb to twelfth.

The title chase has swung slightly in Bridlington Town's favour after the Seasiders opened up a six point lead at the top of the KoolSport NCEL Premier Division.

They claimed a 3-1 victory at home to Maltby Main whilst second placed Rainworth Miners Welfare were beaten at Selby Town.
