Tadcaster Albion have moved to the top of KoolSport NCEL Division One after Tuesday night's 3-0 win at Worsbrough Bridge Athletic.

Tom Matthews, Danny Pitts and then Marc Thompson from the penalty ensured a comfortable victory against the bottom side to put them ahead of Brighouse Town on goal difference with two games in hand.

Pontefract Collieries climb to fifth after two wins in midweek, firstly a 1-0 win at Eccleshill United on Tuesday courtesy of a Carl Fothergill penalty and then a 3-2 win at home to Bottesford Town on Thursday.

Two penalties were converted by Craig Rouse whilst Mark Lafferty ensured the victory with an 88th minute winner after Simon Drayton had also struck twice for the visitors.

Bottesford did have some cheer earlier on in the week as a first half Richard Creer own goal and second period strikes from Craig Bridge and Mark Anderson ensured a 3-0 victory over visitors Grimsby Borough on Tuesday.

The visitors, who are now virtually certain of finishing in the bottom two as a result of their defeat, had a miserable day all round.

They had to start the game with ten men after a car carrying four of their players broke down on their way to Queensgate.

Armthorpe Welfare were beaten 1-0 at home by a Lincoln Moorlands Railway side who secured their place out of the bottom two with that victory.

Hallam's victory came as a relief for the Sandycote side as they were beaten 5-0 at home by Winterton Rangers 48 hours earlier, Liam Wilkinn grabbing two for the visitors.

In Division One, third-placed Leeds Carnegie kept themselves within touching distance of the top two with a 3-1 victory at Worsbrough Bridge Athletic, Andy Cooper struck twice whilst Matt Chilton also found the net.

Damion Liddle and Wayne Harratt struck for Hemsworth Miners Welfare in their 2-0 victory at home to Pontefract Collieries whilst Yorkshire Amateur triumphed by the same scoreline over visitors Eccleshill United.

Barton Town Old Boys were 1-0 winners at AFC Emley, Gareth Barlow with the vital strike on 70 minutes.

Bridlington Town have been crowned champions of the KoolSport NCEL Premier Division with four games still to go.

The Seasiders knew the title, that they last won in 2003, would be theirs if results went their way.

They did their bit, Ashley Allanson's seventeenth-minute penalty earning them a 1-0 win at home to Hall Road Rangers.

Now, they had to wait to see if Armthorpe Welfare had slipped up at Thackley to hand them the trophy.

And, the celebrations began when it came through that Thackley had won 3-0 with goals from Matthew Mathers, Ross Daly and Luke Hudson.

The title triumph is thoroughly deserved for Bridlington who have been consistently the best side in the League this season.

But, there still could be drama in the top flight.

With it still being unclear whether Bridlington will take promotion to the UniBond League on financial grounds, the race is still on for second place.

If the Seasiders decide not to go up, then that would be good enough for promotion and currently three sides are in with a shout.

Armthorpe remain the best placed but third-placed Thackley moved to within three points of them with

Staveley Miners Welfare are now five points clear in fourth place after they won 4-2 at AFC Emley.

A Ryan Damms penalty put them ahead early on but their hosts, playing their last game of the season, drew level through Rob Day before the interval and then took the lead courtesy of Marc Townsend on 65 minutes.

But, three goals in as many minutes turned the game around again with Joel Birks, Judd Colley and Scott Bates all finding the net.

Pontefract Collieries lost ground in fifth as they were beaten 1-0 at home by Barton Town Old Boys, Gareth Barlow with the vital goal on 87 minutes in a very even game.

Andrew Culshaw netted a hat-trick for Rossington Main as they won 3-1 at home to Yorkshire Amateur.

Eccleshill United condemned Worsbrough Bridge Athletic to the wooden spoon as they beat them 3-0 at Plumpton Park.

Worsbrough are now seven points behind their nearest rivals, Grimsby Borough, with only two games to play.

And, Teversal drew 3-3 at home to Glasshoughton Welfare. In a game of many twists and turns, Rob Orton grabbed a couple for the home side whilst Stephen Richards netted a brace for Welfare.

The eight Division One teams for next season's Presidents Cup have been confirmed, meanwhile, with Brighouse, Tadcaster, Leeds Carnegie, Staveley, Pontefract, Barton Town, AFC Emley and Hemsworth all guaranteed a top eight finish.
