Barlow Reaches Double Century

Barton Town Old Boys' most prolific ever scorer notched up his 200th goal for the KoolSport NCEL Division One club this weekend.



Gareth Barlow's superb turn-and-volley to get his club's second in a 9-0 victory at Appleby Frodingham was described by home supporters as the best goal they had seen this season.



It was a fitting time to reach his personal milestone as he did it at the club where he began his non-league career before moving to Barton in 2005.

He netted 45 goals in his first season as the Swans won the Central Midlands League Supreme Division title but, due to ground grading issues, they would have to wait for another year to move up into the NCEL when Gareth's tally of 40 goals led them to the runners-up spot.

At the new level, he scored 24 in all competitions in 2007/08, 26 in the following campaign and then 32 last season.

Yesterday's strike made it 33 for the 2010/11 season, taking him to the magical 200 mark, and the feat is all the more remarkable when you consider that he does not take penalties.

Farsley AFC took a major step towards winning the KoolSport NCEL Premier Division trophy in midweek without even playing as both their title rivals dropped points on their travels.

Bridlington Town played out a goalless match at Long Eaton United whilst Parkgate drew 1-1 at Scarborough Athletic.

Chris Wood's 61st minute penalty earned them the point after Gary Hepples had put the Seadogs ahead.

It means that Farsley are now eleven points clear of Parkgate having played two games more whilst Bridlington are twelve points behind the leaders with three matches in hand.

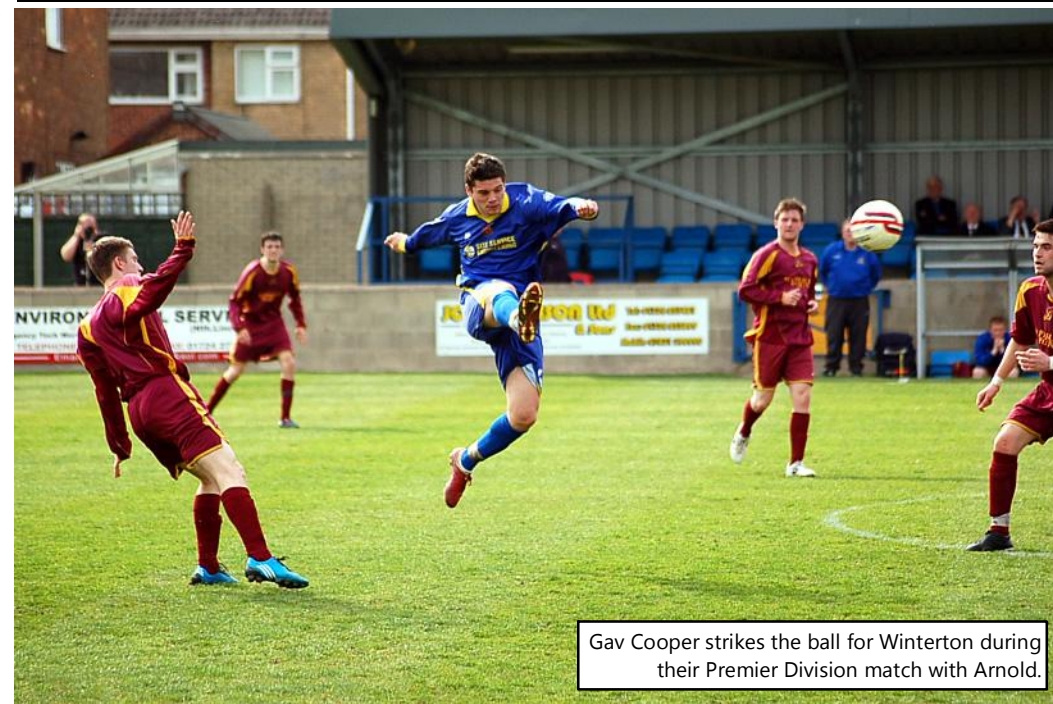
